



SCIS Conduct Agreement

China Trips are a unique and enjoyable experience for everyone involved. It is essential that all SCIS students act with integrity at all times and adhere to the same high standards that are expected of them when in school. The Trip leaders will attend to the safety of each individual, the safety of the group and the principles of the SCIS while expecting all members of the group to follow their direction and example. The China Trips are considered an extension of the classroom. Therefore, any misconduct will be immediately addressed and dealt with appropriately.

- 1) I am aware that the use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances will not be allowed. Furthermore, if I enter an environment where these activities are occurring, I am aware that I should immediately leave the environment or else I am considered equally guilty of violating this policy.
- 2) I am aware that I will remain with the SCIS group and under SCIS supervision at all times, unless permission is granted specifically from the supervisors
- 3) I agree to follow group curfews (times to be inside the hotel rooms and in bed with lights out) as decided by the trip leaders. I also understand that under no circumstance should I be alone in a hotel room with someone of the opposite sex (unless accompanied by a trip leader).
- 4) I will conduct myself in a safe and respectful manner during the entire trip, including during any transport.
- 5) I will not change the accommodation arrangements without the permission of the trip leaders.
- 6) I agree to report any unusual circumstances or problems that arise during the trip directly to the trip leaders.
- 7) I agree to follow all existing Chinese laws.

If any of rules are violated during the period of China Trips, the responsible student/s will be sent home on the next available flight at their family's expense. Further consequences may also be possible, to be decided upon by the administration of SCIS.
